## THE KIPP APPEAL

Dear Friend of Kippford,

***IT'S YOUR LAND – THE TIME HAS COME!***



The Kippford Association are writing to ask for your help towards the purchase of The Kipp land.

Many of you will be aware that The Kipp Ltd was created in 2005 with the support of the Kippford Association to enable the purchase of this land for the local community.

This purchase, as approved at the Special General Meeting in March 2016, is for the benefit of everyone with an interest in the village and will ensure that we save Open Space for the enjoyment of all, to the benefit of our environment and the flora and fauna around our village.

You will know that there has been a long legal process to remove an illegal occupant from part of our land. The Kipp Ltd has won all court cases and he has now been removed from the land. The land is now free of all cattle.

**THIS APPEAL IS URGENT - PLEASE DONATE WHAT YOU CAN**

The Association need to raise £52,000 to put the land into the ownership of the Kippford Association. Over £7,000 has been raised so far – including \$1,000 from the USA!
